

PRAYING FOR YOUR FAMILY

A Daily Prayer Guide for My Family Five Prayer Points

1. Covering and Protection Over My Family

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.” Numbers 6:24–26

Father, I place my wife or husband, my children or lack of, and my entire extended family under Your covering today. Guard their hearts, minds, bodies, and paths. Protect them from harm, deception, temptation, and discouragement. Let Your peace rest over our homes, our travels, our work, and our relationships. I ask that Your presence would go before us and remain with us in every place.

2. Hearts that Love God and Walk with Him

“As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.” Joshua 24:15

Lord, draw the hearts of my family toward You. For my children, establish a love for truth and a hunger for Your Word. For my wife, strengthen her walk with You and refresh her spirit. For my extended family, reveal Yourself clearly to them. Shape our desires so that we delight in what delights You and turn away from what does not honor You.

3. Wisdom, Discernment, and Godly Direction

“If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault.” James 1:5

God, we ask for wisdom beyond our own understanding. Guide decisions big and small. Give my wife /husband and me clarity as parents and unity in leadership. Give our children discernment in friendships, education, and calling. Order the steps of our family and align us with Your purposes. Help us recognize Your voice and respond with obedience.

4. Unity, Love, and Healthy Relationships

“Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.” 1 Peter 4:8

Lord, strengthen love and unity within our family. Heal past wounds and soften hardened places. Guard our words so that we speak life and not harm. Teach us to forgive quickly, listen well, and serve one another humbly. Let our marriage reflect Your covenant faithfulness and our family relationships reflect You.

5. Blessing, Purpose, and Generational Fruit

“The Lord will establish you as his holy people, as he promised you on oath.” Deuteronomy 28:9

Father, I ask that Your blessing would rest on our family for generations. Release purpose over each life represented in our family line. Let what we do today bear fruit in our children and their children after them. Use our family as a testimony of Your faithfulness and goodness. May we be a blessing to others and a light in every place You send us.
